PROGRAM:

Marajó Island 3-day trip

Located in the middle of the Amazon estuary, Marajó is the world's largest river island, with an area the same size as Belgium. The emblematic animal is a big and very peaceful black cow: the buffalo.

Day 1: 3-hour boat trip to Soure, on the Marajó coast, and transfer to hotel. Afternoon: departure to the mangrove area known as Barra Velha distinguished by its vegetation and freshwater crab fishing. Optional 1 km walk along the Barra Velha beachfront.

Day 2: After breakfast, departure to the city of Salvaterra and the historic village of Joanes. Bathing on a freshwater beach.

Day 3: After breakfast, discovery of the city of Soure, the tannery (Buffalo Leather Craft Processing Center), the fishermen's village, where Pesqueiro Beach stands out with its coconut trees, stalls, and white sand, with the possibility of riding a Marajó buffalo on the beach. Expected arrival in Belém at 4:30 pm.

Marajó Island 1-day trip

Located in the middle of the Amazon estuary, Marajó is the world's largest river island, with an area the same size as Belgium. The emblematic animal is a big and very peaceful black cow: the buffalo.

Boat trip to Soure, on the Marajó coast. Discovery of mangrove and freshwater beach at Barra Velha. Visit of the city of Soure, the tannery (Buffalo Leather Craft Processing Center) and the fishermen's village. Lunch and bathing at Pesqueiro Beach.

Mosqueiro Island 1-day trip

Discovery of the local history and culture of the Mosqueiro village, including the traditional tapioca house offering dishes made with tapioca gum, and testimonies of the local religious devotion like the image of Our Lady pregnant. Bathing and lunch on a freshwater beach with no view of the opposite shore.

Combú Island Morning and lunch

Boating along the Guamá River banks among the famous popopós until the Combú Stream, considered the 1st River Gallery of the Amazon, the result of an art collective led by graffiti artists under the project of Sebastião Tapajós Jr. Visit to Dona Nena's cocoa plantation and organic chocolate factory. Walk through the Amazon forest ecosystem. Lunch based on local fish in typical riverside restaurant, with free time for swimming and enjoying nature.

Parrot Island, creeks and streams 1-day trip

Departure from the hotel at 5 a.m. Boat trip to Parrot Island. An impressive flock of birds. Navigation through a labyrinth of waterways in the middle of the forest with emblematic Amazonian tree species. Discovery of local fishing and farming activities. Lunch in typical riverside restaurant.

For all tours:

Transport to and from hotel.

Bring suitable clothing for outdoor activities, sun protection and cash for restaurant and local purchases.
